Will Signing Instructions - Scotland



A Will becomes legally valid and binding as soon as it is correctly signed by the Granter and observed by an Independent Witness, who will sign to confirm this fact. It is important that you **SIGN AND DATE** your Will in front of the Witness as soon as possible, **BUT PLEASE READ THE REST OF THIS PAGE FIRST**.

An example of how to sign your Will

- The signing of your Will involves
 TWO people, you and a Witness.
- 2. The **WITNESS** must be over **16** years old.
- Make sure that the Witness is as independent as possible. An ideal Witness could be a neighbour or colleague.
- 4. The WITNESS must NOT be a Beneficiary, spouse of any beneficiaries or member of your own family (even if the Beneficiary has been named as second or third reserve to inherit any part of the estate. Making the mistake of signing as a Witness means that they will lose their inheritance).
- Ask your WITNESS to add their "usual" signatures, where required.
- They should also print their name, address and occupation clearly for identification purposes.
- 7. In addition to the requirements above, you also need to sign **EACH** page at the bottom of your Will on the same day and in the presence of the Witness.
